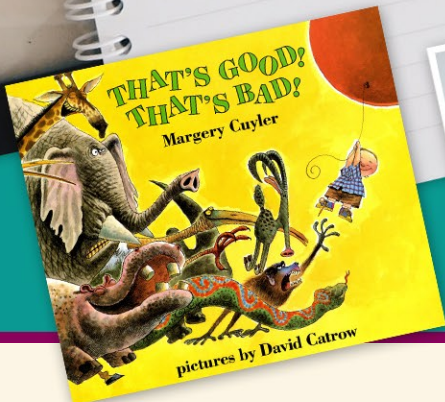

Using her book *That's Good! That's Bad!* as the springboard for a communal storytelling exercise, she emphasizes the importance of the revision process.
